Plastic Soap Dish

What You Need:

- 1 or two liter plastic bottle, empty clean and dry
- Hole punch
- Scissors
- Paint markers
- Craft knife



What You Do;

- 1. Help your child start the project by cutting a slit with a craft knife into the bottle at the half-way point. The slit should be large enough that your child can slide a hole punch into the bottle.
- 2. Have them slide the hole punch into the bottle and punch out a hole. Then draw a straight line around the bottle matching up to either side of the punched out hole.
- 3. Use the scissors to cut along the line. The hole punch should be enough area to begin cutting from.
- 4. Recycle the top portion of the bottle, or set it aside for another project.
- 5. Draw a wavy line around the top edge of the cut bottle to create a scalloped edge. Cut around the wavy line and recycle the leftover plastic.
- 6. Use the paint markers to design a fun and beautiful pattern around the base of the plastic bottle, turning it into a soap dish.
- 7. Place your favorite smelling soap in your new dish while you help save the environment.
